

ZOO LICENSING ACT 1981

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO APPLY FOR A
ZOO LICENCE**

Form for the notice which applicants seeking a licence for a new zoo (or applicants subject to a direction under section 6(1) (b) of the Act) are required to publish in one local and one national newspaper and to exhibit at the site of the proposed zoo, in accordance with section 2(1) of the Act.

1. I / We [insert name and address of intended applicant/s] hereby give notice that in not less than two months after publication of this notice.

I / We intend to make application to Council [insert name of local authority for the area within which the whole or major part of the zoo is situated] for a licence to operate a proposed zoo at [insert situation of zoo]
